

1. This will be a handicapped tournament. Handicap will be based on 80% of difference of team total averages and 1150
2. Teams must bowl in the order that they have submitted the names on the front of the application. Bowler 1 will bowl the 1st and 6th frames, Bowler 2 will bowl the 2nd and 7th frames, Bowler 3 will bowl the 3rd and 8th frames, Bowler 4 will bowl the 4th and 9th frames, and Bowler 5 will bowl the 5th and 10th frames.
3. All teams will bowl a 4 game series.
4. All bowlers must use their highest book average from the 2022-2023 bowling season. Sanctioned bowlers without a book average from 2022-2023 season will be able to use their current year average based on 21 games. If less than 21 games, or previously not a sanctioned bowler, participants will use the higher of their current average or the assigned average of:
Girls – 100 Boys – 125 Women – 140 Men – 175
5. Alcoholic beverages will NOT be permitted in the area of the youth bowlers
6. Winning teams in Division 1 and 2 will be awarded SMART scholarships based on entries. Winning team will also receive medallions for first place, and a sponsor trophy presented to the team bowling center.
